

Children's Percentile


Child Income Rank

- Higher parent rank \rightarrow Higher college attendance rate and higher college quality rank
- For low college quality rank: Increase in parent income is less important

Who Become an Inventor in America? The Importance of Exposure to Innovation Quarterly Journal of Economics, 2018



- Steeply upward sloping among higher-income families
- High-income family → Child is likely to be inventor

Nationally, higher parent rank → Higher child rank Same college tier, different family → Similar child rank




