


An Analysis on Scheme \$6000 to Predict the Effectiveness of the Caring and Sharing Scheme






Results



% Change of Consumption Price Index



1.Price level rose —> Purchasing power decreased

2.Decreased the effect of increasing the real GDP


Methodology

Data Source:

- 1. Census and Statistics Department
- 2. Survey distributed on social platforms

Respondence:

37 people who were eligible to get \$6000 in 2011



Results

\$6000 Scheme launched: 08/2011 to 12/2012

\$2,131,050m

\$37,000m

Late 2011 - 2012 Consumption 15

Total distribution in \$6000 Scheme

Assume all receivers used up \$6000

Policy Effect:\$(2131050-2094050)/2094050m

= 1.7669% increase in consumption

Prediction

One-off consumption



Price level effect



Insufficient amount



Caring and Sharing Scheme will NOT effective to stimulate the economy
